Over the past 20 years, U.S. agricultural exports:

## TRIPLED to Canada



- **#9 BUYER** of U.S. corn (64.2 million bushels)
- **#8 BUYER** of U.S. DDGS (654,000 MT)
- **#2 BUYER** of U.S. ethanol (337 million gallons)
- **#2 BUYER** of U.S. barley (4 million bushels)

- **#1 BUYER** of U.S. corn (618 million bushels)
- **#1 BUYER** of U.S. DDGS (2.13 MMT)
