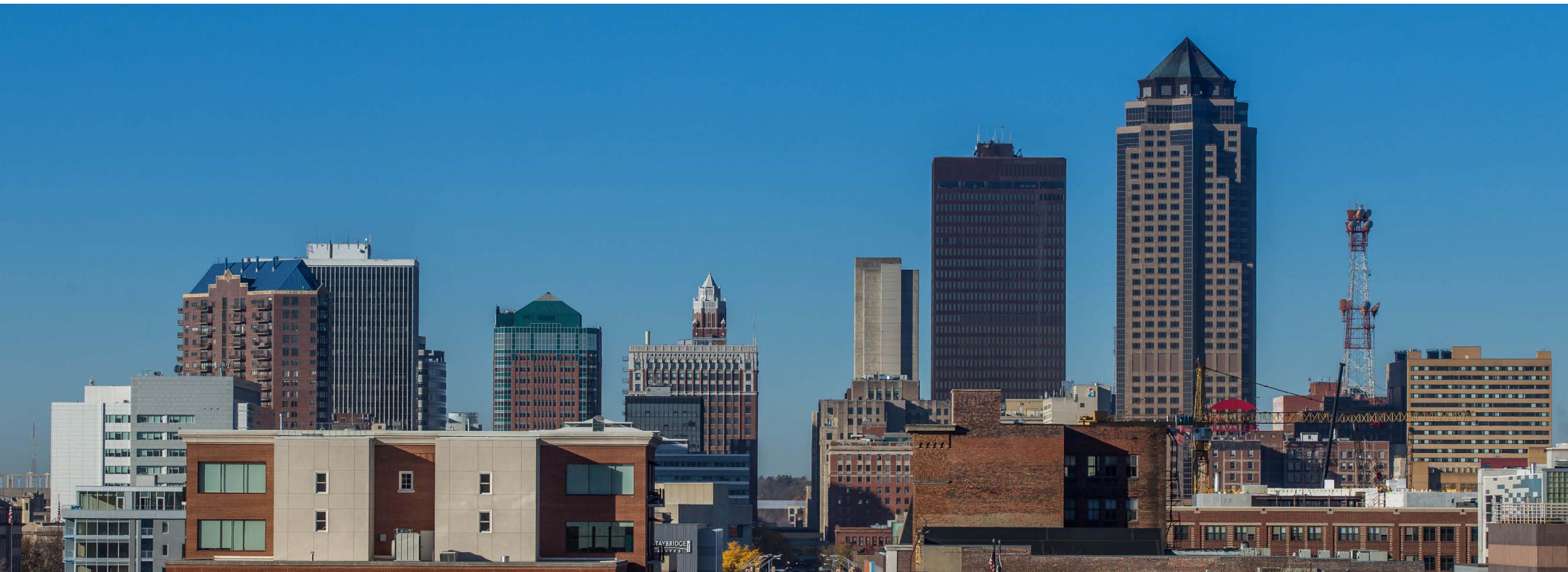

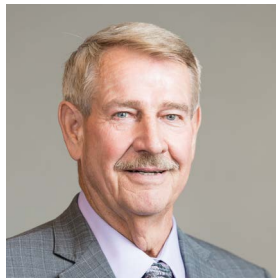

Make reservations online at the Council's website, www.grains.org/desmoines, or by calling the hotel's reservations department at (515) 241-1456 and mention the U.S. Grains Council meeting to receive the discounted rate. Reservations deadline is Friday, July 2, 2021. After this date, the hotel will accept reservations on a space-available basis.

The Council has negotiated a room rate of \$134 USD per night, single or double occupancy, plus 15 percent tax. Check-in time is 3 p.m.; check-out time is 12 p.m.

Ground Transportation

The Des Moines Hilton Downtown and Iowa Events Center is approximately 15 minutes from the Des Moines International Airport (airport code DSM). Transportation to the hotel via taxi will cost approximately \$22 one-way. Uber and Lyft are available at an estimated cost of \$15 one-way.

Attire

Business casual attire is appropriate for all meetings. Casual attire with comfortable shoes is appropriate for offsite. In Des Moines, the average high temperature for July is 83 degrees with an average low of 66 degrees.

CDC Guidelines

The Council will be following all CDC event location guidelines. As of May 19, the guidelines of the hotel and convention center require each attendee have their temperature taken and complete a health screening survey. The survey will ask if you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19. Masks are mandatory to wear throughout the whole program, except while actively eating a meal. Social distancing will be adhered to in meeting rooms, eating rooms and the convention center.
