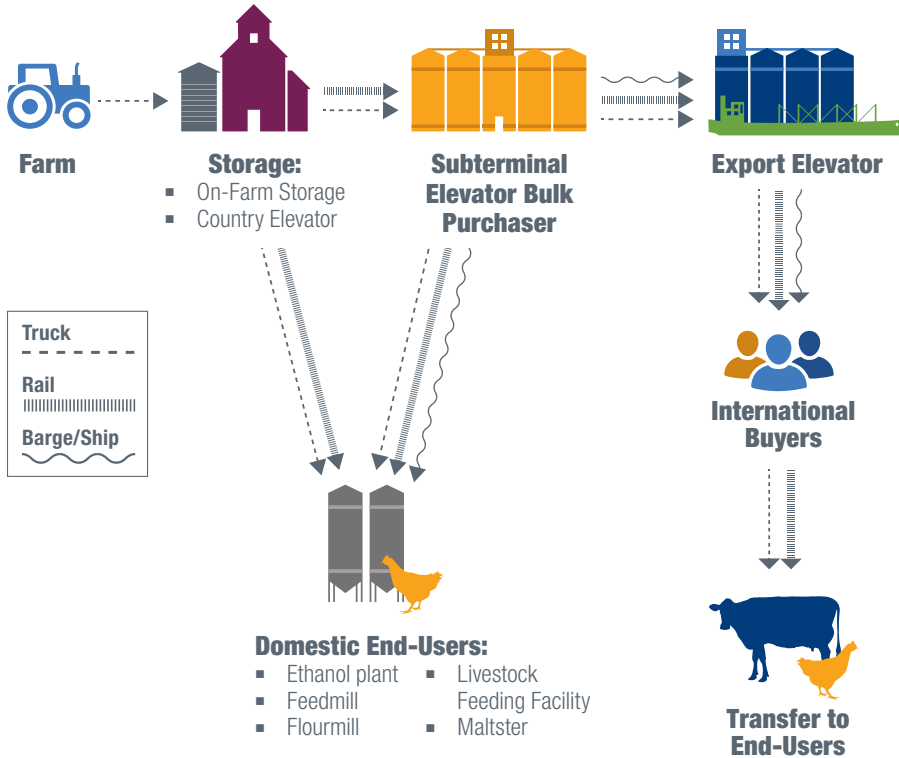


# HOW DOES U.S. GRAIN MOVE?



## THE UNITED STATES HAS:

**164,000**

miles (263,932 km) of highways, part of a 4-million mile public road network.

**12,000**

miles (19,312 km) of navigable waterways.

**140,000**

miles (225,308 km) of freight railways.
