Market Outlook: U.S. ethanol prices ended last week 6.4 percent higher but have since stabilized, ending unchanged from Fiday as of Tuesday's close. Midwest wholesale rack ethanol prices were higher to end last week but are down 0.7 percent through Tuesday's market close to their last quote of 66.95 cents/liter (253.43 cents/gallon).


FOB Houston ethanol prices finished last week 0.8 percent higher and are up 4.4 percent through Tuesday's trading from Friday's close. FOB Houston ethanol prices are quoted at 65.25 cents/liter (247.01 cents/gallon). FOB Santos, Brazil anhydrous ethanol prices were lower last week; they are down in early week trading, falling 0.3 percent to 73.8 cents/liter (279.35 cents/gallon) through Tuesday's trading.

The FOB Gulf-Santos, Brazil ethanol spread has narrowed from last week's close through Tuesday's trading and is currently at -8.54 cents/liter (-32.34 cents/gallon).


MTBE prices rose 5.9 percent last week and are extending those gains in early week trading, up 2.1 percent from Friday's close through Tuesday's trading. MTBE's premium to FOB Houston ethanol has decreased from last week's report and stands at -3.14 cents/liter (-11.9 cents/gallon).

BTX component prices were higher last week and are continuing that trend through Tuesday's market close: Benzene is up 0.8 percent while Toluene is up 6.2 percent, and Xylene is up 2.4 percent. The estimated weighted average aromatic price is currently 75.46 cents/liter (285.63 cents/gallon), up from last Friday's close. The BTX-Houston ethanol spread narrowed last week, and the weighted average BTX price is 10.2 cents/liter (38.62 cents/gallon) higher than the FOB Houston ethanol price.


Gasoline and petroleum products were higher last week but are steady or slightly lower in early week trade. RBOB futures are down 0.2 percent to start the week while 84 octane RBOB (Houston) and 87 octane CBOB (U.S. Gulf) gasoline prices are down 0.1 and up 0 percent, respectively. WTI futures are 0.7 percent higher at \$79.94/barrel while Brent futures are up 0.3 percent to \$82.63/barrel, from Friday through Tuesday's close.




