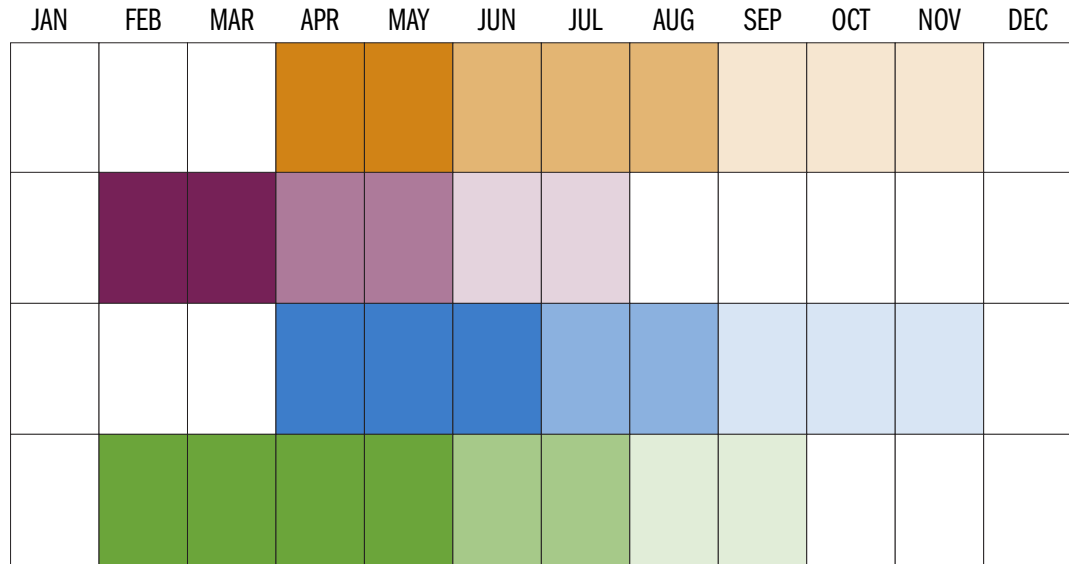






# GROWING SEASONS ACROSS THE COMMODITIES
