GENERAL COMMENTS

The FOB Gulf DDGS to SBM spread for this week was \$112, down from \$116 the previous week. The FOB Gulf DDGS to corn spread is -\$7.48, down from -\$3.72 last week. Overall U.S. ethanol production averaged 1.112 million barrels per day, up 97,000 BPD week over week, the highest production levels in 10 weeks. DDGS prices in Elwood, IL (Delivered ramp) were \$197 per MT, and Kansas City Rail Yard (Delivered ramp) prices were \$193 per MT.


