Market Outlook: U.S. ethanol prices ended last week largely unchanged but pushed higher in early week trading and rose 1.1 percent from Friday through Tuesday's close. Midwest wholesale rack ethanol prices were lower to end last week but were up 1.2 percent through Tuesday's market close to their last quote of 50.79 cents/liter (192.25 cents/gallon).

FOB Houston ethanol prices finished last week 0.7 percent lower but are up 0.8 percent through Tuesday's trading from Friday's close. FOB Houston ethanol prices are quoted at 50.21 cents/liter (190.08 cents/gallon). FOB Santos, Brazil anhydrous ethanol prices were lower last week; they are up in early week trading, rising 0.6 percent to 56.59 cents/liter (214.1975 cents/gallon) through Tuesday's close.

The FOB Gulf-Santos, Brazil ethanol spread has narrowed from last week's close through Tuesday's trading and is currently at -6.37 cents/liter (-24.12 cents/gallon).


MTBE prices fell 12.9 percent last week and extended that selloff in early week trading to fall 7 percent from Friday's close through Tuesday's trading. MTBE's premium to FOB Houston ethanol has decreased from last week's report and stands at -0.06 cents/liter (-0.23 cents/gallon).

BTX component prices were sharply lower last week and continued that trend through Tuesday's market close: Benzene was down 6 percent while Toluene was down 3.2 percent, and Xylene was down 3.2 percent. The estimated weighted average aromatic price is currently 68.44 cents/liter (259.08 cents/gallon), down from last Friday's close. The BTX-Houston ethanol spread narrowed last week, and the weighted average BTX price is 18.23 cents/liter (69.01 cents/gallon) higher than the FOB Houston ethanol price.


Gasoline and petroleum products were lower last week but strengthened in early week trade. RBOB futures are up 0.6 percent to start the week while 84 octane RBOB (Houston) and 87 octane CBOB (U.S. Gulf) gasoline prices are up 2.1 and up 1.6 percent, respectively. WTI futures are 1.3 percent lower at \$60.69/barrel while Brent futures are down 1.1 percent to \$64.06/barrel, from Friday through Tuesday's close.


Liquid tanker rates are 2 percent higher on average this week with offers for the U.S. Gulf to South Korea seeing the largest gains (up 3 percent). Freight from the U.S. Gulf to the West Coast of Central America saw the largest declines and is down 1 percent from last week. On average, tanker freight from the U.S. Gulf is up 2 percent this week while freight from the PNW has posted a 3 percent increase. Liquid tanker freight rates from Brazil are up 2 percent, on average, this week. Freight rates across all origins are 13 percent lower than this same week in 2024.

On a cost-and-freight (C&F) basis, offers are mostly higher this week as both freight rates and FOB ethanol offers have climbed higher. Prices for ethanol C&F to Central America from the U.S. Gulf are up 0.8 percent this week and are up 5.6 percent from this same week in 2024. Values for PNW ethanol to Southeast Asia average \$755.47/MT this week, up 1.5 percent from the prior week and up 4.9 percent year-over-year. That compares to U.S. Gulf to Southeast Asia C&F prices that average \$740.77/MT and are up 1 percent from last week and are up 3.3 percent year-over-year. C&F prices for Brazilian ethanol to Southeast Asia are up 0.3 percent from last week.





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


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





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



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


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





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



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
