#### **GENERAL COMMENTS**

The FOB Gulf DDGS to SBM spread for this week was \$78, down from \$87 the previous week. The FOB Gulf DDGS to corn spread is \$35.63, up from \$35.26 last week. Overall ethanol production in the United States averaged 1.109 million bpd, down 11,000 bpd week-on-week and 66,000 bpd, or 6% higher than in the same week last year.


